

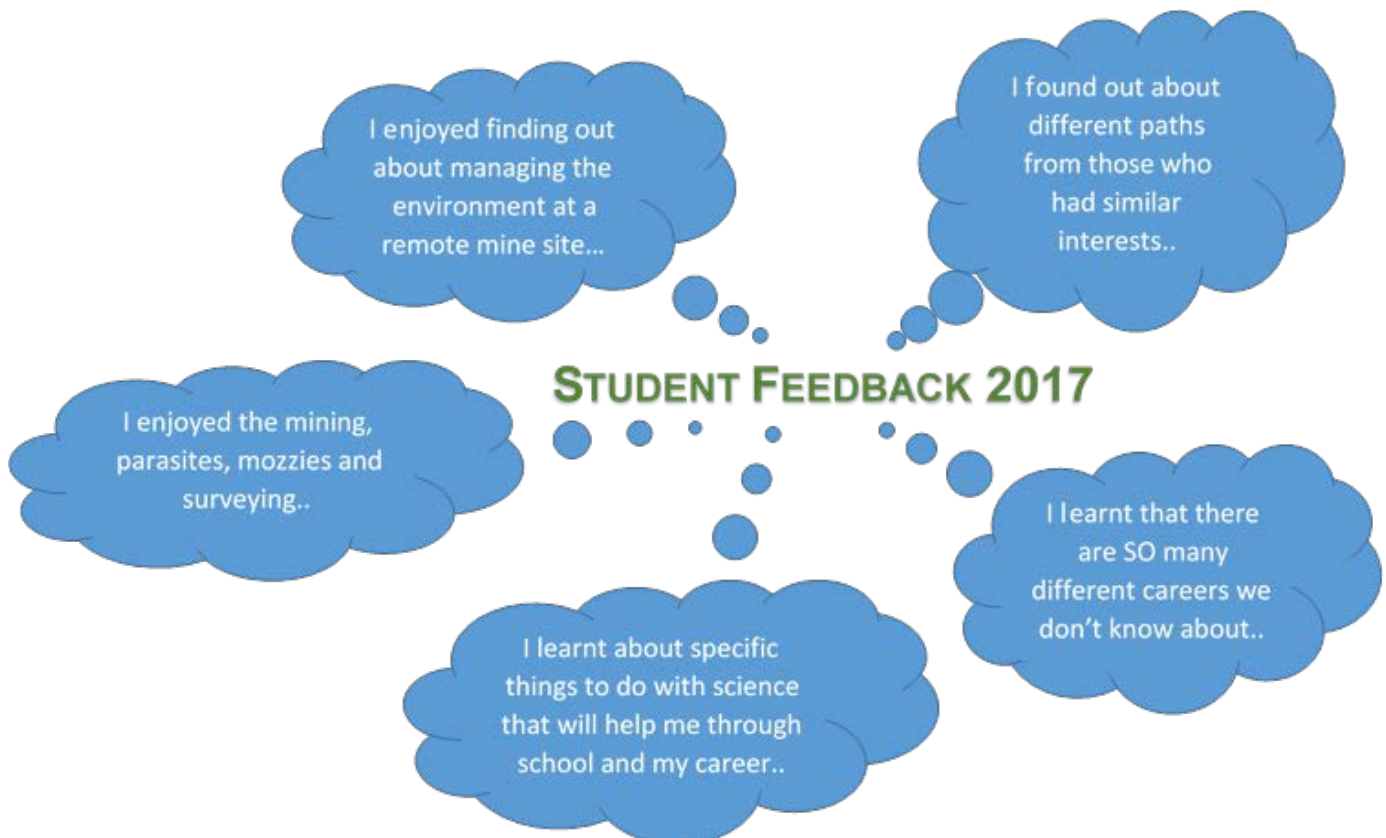
Hi,
