You leave your worm farm in the hot sun and go away on holidays and the worms die! **GO BACK TO START**

You start a compost bin at home. **MOVE FORWARD ONE SPACE**

You stop dad adding orange and onion peels to your worm farm. He puts them in the compost bin instead. **MOVE FORWARD TWO SPACES**

Those autumn leaves go straight from the rake into your worm farm. **MOVE FORWARD ONE SPACE**

There is a compost bin at school but you put your lunch scraps in the rubbish bin instead. **MOVE BACK ONE PLACE**

16
You make a salad and put all the vegetable scraps into your compost bin. **MOVE FORWARD TWO SPACES**

You remind mum to take picnic scraps home for your compost or worm farm and not put them in the rubbish bin. **MOVE FORWARD ONE PLACE**

No need to buy fertiliser full of chemicals Dad! Use natural "worm fertilizer" for better results. **MOVE FORWARD ONE PLACE**

Mulch on the garden keeps down weeds and uses less water. **MOVE FORWARD TWO PLACES**

You keep the paper bag your take-away meal was in and put it in the worm farm. **MOVE FORWARD ONE PLACE**

You shred your used pizza boxes and add them to your worm farm. **MOVE FORWARD ONE SPACE**

You wrap your vegie scraps in plastic and throw them in the bin. They could have gone into your compost bin or worm farm. **MOVE BACK ONE SPACE**

You start a worm farm. Worms are the world's best recyclers. **MOVE FORWARD THREE SPACES**
